
Giving Names

Receiving a name is a sign of belonging and of love. Your family carefully chose a name just for you. Think about a toy that you gave a special name to. On the lines, tell about your toy. Next, put the name your family gave you.



Family Note: Your child is learning about belonging. If you do this activity with your child, explain about the time you spent choosing just the right name. Mention that at Baptism, your child became a member of the Church, God's Family.

Catechist Note: Use this activity with Chapter 1, "Belonging." If you wish, each child can bring in one toy that she or he has named. Each child can fill out the two name tags, one to wear and one to tape on her or his toy. You can use the child's name tag as a way for the children to learn each other's names.
